# FLOWER CALENDAR

(SECOND EDITION - REVISED)

While the exact time of a plant's first appearance cannot be definitely foretold a grouping by calendar months will be found approximately correct from year to year.

The facts in this bulletin should afford a convenient aid toward naming the common Rhode Island flowers as well as determining when and where they may be found.

The arrangement is based on data secured during the past eight years from our Flower Table.

The scientific names are from Gray's Manual of Botany, 7th edition.

Tassels of Tag Alder, Birch, Poplars and Willows are Spring's earliest signs of awakening life in March. The Maples and Elms blossom in April.
